

## EVEREST BASE CAMP: INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

### INCLUSIONS

- ✓ Personal expedition build-up in the UK
- ✓ Meet and greet at UK airport and transfer to your hotel in Kathmandu
- ✓ 3 nights in the Kathmandu Guest House including all meals
- ✓ Visit to the Durbar Square, Swaymbhunath (Monkey Temple) and Pasupitinath.
- ✓ Return domestic flights to Lukla
- ✓ All National Park Fees and TIMS (Trekking Information Management System) Card Fees
- ✓ Two experienced UK mountain trek leaders who will accompany you at all times\*
- ✓ Accommodation in teahouses on a room only basis (based on 2 people sharing a room)
- ✓ One local porter per person carrying no more than 15kg plus local trekking guide(s)
- ✓ Fully comprehensive Travel Insurance including medical repatriation
- ✓ 24 Hour Operations Room in the UK and Safety Management and Emergency Response Systems in-country (Oxygen, Full Expedition First Aid Kit and Communications Package)

### EXCLUSIONS

- ✗ International airfares and transport to and from UK airport
- ✗ Personal Kit, Equipment and Vaccinations
- ✗ Nepalese Visa Costs on arrival (\$30 US Dollars)
- ✗ Insurance for the lost or damage of personal equipment including cameras
- ✗ Food whilst on the trek – this can be purchased in the teahouses (approx. \$30 per day)
- ✗ Internet access in tea-houses and charging of electrical devices
- ✗ Other meals, food and drinks not specified as being provided
- ✗ Any alcoholic beverages
- ✗ Tips for local guides and porters

\*A Venture Force expedition will comprise of a maximum of 10 clients supported by two Venture Force leaders (plus local porters and guides). However, where the number of clients falls below 6, we will discuss the possibility of providing a single Venture Leader with the team. Venture Force reserve the right to cancel the expedition due to a lack of clients or for safety reasons. If this is the case, you will be refunded in full (including deposit). Venture Force will keep you informed of any changes to the expedition and the final confirmation of the expedition status will be provided by the 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017.
