\*Vaccinations: Venture Force try hard to provide a true cost for the expedition. However where vaccinations are concerned our hands are tied! Some students will have travelled extensively and thus require few additional vaccinations but others may require more or, due to individual medical conditions, require different vaccinations. Thus our estimation is just that! We recommend that at an early stage you visit your travel clinic, taking along our itinerary. This will give the experts a true idea of where we will be travelling and just as importantly spread the cost over the 12 months.
