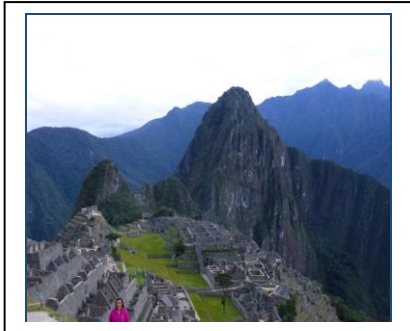

Outline Itinerary:

Jungle Experience	The Amazon Jungle is a world of its own. Having travelled by boat into the Jungle our teams live with a family alongside the mighty Rio Tambopata experiencing some of the Wildlife – ‘Clay Lick’ and a night-time Cayman hunting river safari (cameras only).
Community Project	Our interactive community project will take place in the small village of Mollepatte set high in the Andes and perfect for Acclimatisation before our Salkantay trek. Previous teams have lived with this friendly mountain village repairing the roof to the community school. New teams will assist in the development of the school, learning about village life in this remote mountain community. All Venture Force projects provide a worthwhile solution to one of the community’s problems and provide an ideal opportunity for our teams to live amongst the community.
Salkantay Trek	From the small mountain community our teams trek the stunningly beautiful Salkantay Trail (one of the most famous Inca routes) that eventually takes us to the hidden Inca city of Machu Pichuu.
Machu Pichuu	Teams arrive at the gates of the wondrous city in time for the photographs before the sunset. A guided tour around the city ends with a chance to climb the magnificent Waynu Pichuu that is the best location for an overall view of the city – but not for the faint hearted.
White Water Rafting	From Cusco the teams are taken into the Andes Mountains for a day white knuckle Rafting that is a fantastic way to end the trip and relax before travelling home.

**Vaccinations: Venture Force try hard to give a true cost for the expedition. However where vaccinations are concerned our hands are tied! Some students will have travelled extensively and thus require few additional vaccinations but others may require more or, due to individual medical conditions require different vaccinations. Thus our estimation is just that! We recommend that at an early stage you visit your travel clinic, taking along our itinerary. This will give the experts a true idea of where we will be travelling and just as importantly spread the cost over the 12 months.*

***Personal Equipment: Our kit list is based around what the normal person will already have in an effort to keep cost to a minimum. We can arrange an evening presentation either at the school or at an outdoor clothing outlet for advice and an idea of expected cost. There is no pressure for clients to purchase items from the outlet.*

Overview:
