- ✓ We like to think we are different from other commercial providers; we strive to ensure that all our expeditions are run as ethically as possible. Here are just some of the ways we make your expedition to Everest Base Camp a special one.
- ✓ One porter per person (carrying no more than 15kg). We really look after our local porters and not only does our method of one porter per person provide more work to local people, it also ensures that the porters are not overworked and taken advantage of.
- ✓ Two Venture Force Leaders to ensure safety. This means you will never be left alone in a tea house if you haven't acclimatised properly.
- ✓ Provide each porter with warm clothing such as a warm jacket and woolly hat.
- ✓ We ensure that our local guides and porters are well paid and well looked after with enough food and warm clothing to ensure a safe expedition for them.
- ✓ We buy our branded goods from Cornerstone, a UK charity, aimed at getting adults with learning difficulties into work. We take no profit from this.
- ✓ Our expedition teams will **not be bigger than 10 clients** allowing you to feel part of a **close and tight-knit team** rather than a fish in an ocean of other trekkers. This will give you a first-class experience of the incredible journey where you feel safe and secure and will give you a chance to get to know everyone in the group, including the leaders.
